The American Red Cross of Ventura County will be holding an enrollment event on Sunday January 13th from 10 am - 5 pm at the Goebel Adult Community Center – located at [1385 E. Janss Road, Thousand Oaks 91362](#). The registration event will be held in the meeting rooms located on the West side of the building. This event is open to all residents whose homes received major damage or were destroyed due to the Hill or Woolsey fires and have not received financial assistance from FEMA or from the Red Cross.

This event is being offered with the support of the City of Thousand Oaks, Conejo Recreation and Park District, Ventura County United Way and Ventura County VOAD.

To qualify for assistance, all applicants are asked to bring both proof of identification and proof of residency. Examples of accepted documentation include:
